OKLAHOMA CITY, OK
APRIL 30, 1997

Compared to last week: Feeder and stocker steers under 800 lbs and heifers under 700 lbs steady; heavier weights 2.00 higher. Demand very good for feeders and stockers, fair for calves. Receipts reduced by general rains of 1-3 inches over the trade area late last week. This causing the usual difficulty in gathering and moving cattle from pastures. Quality of supply attractive to mostly average. Fleish condition of feeders mostly medium. Calves again mixed in flesh as new crops and a few thin dry wintered calves comprise the supply. Weigh-ups gaunt to average. Receipts this week 5,600; last week 13,876; last year 8,335. Supply consisted of 83 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 13 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis. Slaughter cows 2.00-3.50 higher. Slaughter bulls 1.50 higher. Packer demand good for light receipts. Packers fairly aggressive as they begin to build inventory for next months Memorial holiday. Total of 240 cows and bulls sold with 70 percent going to packers. 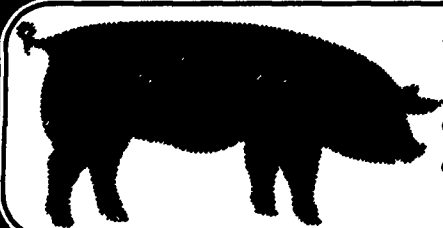
