

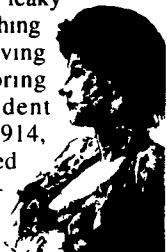

**PECAN STREUSEL**

- 1-1/2 cups sifted flour
- 3 tablespoons baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 cup butter
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 egg
- 1/2 cup orange juice
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans

- TOPPING:**
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
  - 2 tablespoons flour
  - 2 teaspoons cinnamon
  - 1/4 cup melted butter

Combine dry streusel ingredients. Cream butter and sugar. Stir in egg and juice, then dry ingredients and nuts. Pour into greased 9x9-inch pan. Combine topping ingredients and sprinkle over batter. Bake about 30 minutes at 375° F

Makes 9 squares.

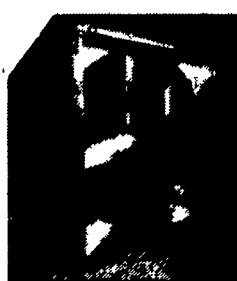

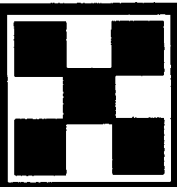
