

Compared to last week: Feeder steers  
 and heifers 2.00-4.00 higher. Calves  
 steady. Demand very good for all classes.

Quality average to attractive, modest end  
 plain. Bulk supply feeder cattle off wheat  
 in medium to moderate flesh conditions.  
 May wheat cattle are normally in mostly  
 moderate to heavy flesh, however this year  
 more cattle in medium conditions. Weight-  
 ups average. Slaughter cows steady to 1.00  
 lower, decline on Utilities. Slaughter bulls  
 weak. Packer demand moderate. Packer  
 buyers taking only 45 percent of supply.  
 Numerous young, light weight, thin cows  
 offered and these headed to grass. Total of  
 650 cows and bulls sold. Receipts this  
 week 13,375; last week 12,850; last year  
 15,433. Supply consisted of 81 percent  
 yearlings over 600 lbs; 14 percent calves  
 and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 5 percent  
 cows and bulls. Prices follow with weight-


