Pasture Walk June 19

FREDERICK, Md. — The next Pasture Walk for Prederick County, Maryland will be Thursday, June 19, from 10 a.m.-noon. Ron and Kathy Holter will be hosting the event.

This is the third year of grazing for Holterholm Farms. They have a variety of perennial grasses established, including orchardgrass, fescue, ryegrass, prairie grass, and reed canarygrass. In addition, white clover, red clover, alfalfa, and chicory are used across the farm. Water is available in every paddock and an all-weather cow lane was installed last year using several different geotextile fabrics.

Feed budgeting will be discussed in detail since the dry spring has many concerned about on-farm feed supplies in a pasturebased system.

The murgose of the Pasture Walk is as allowed vestock producers a chance to learn more about the use of rotational grazing as a way to increase agricultural profitability. Most of the time will be spent walking through the pastures discussing plant growth, fencing, watering systems, feed budgeting, and animal performance.

Holterholm Farms is located at 5903 Holter Road. From Jefferson, go north on Holter Road two mies to farm on the right. From Middletown, go south on Route 17 to immediate left onto Franklin Street (this becomes Holter Road). Go three miles to farm on the left.




