The 1996 Farm Bill removed the acreage report requirement in most cases for county farmers to remain eligible for USDA benefits. The commodity loan program still requires timely filed acreage reports by those who wish to pledge stored commodities as collateral for these nine-month loans.

Producers interested in reporting must visit the county office. review aerial photographs, and indicate their crops location. The office is open Monday thru Friday 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Appointments are encouraged and reduce the farmer's time in the county office.

Final certification dates are June 15, wheat, barley and oats and July 15, corn, soybeans, fruit, and vegetables.


