

# Top Living Lifetime Producers

REYNOLDSBURG, Ohio — The living lifetime production awards recognize the leading lifetime producers of the Guernsey breed based on official production credits verified by the American Guernsey Association.

The following awards will be presented at the American Guernsey Association's annual meeting in LaCrosse, Wisconsin.

This year topping the living lifetime list for milk and protein production is Heart O Gold Teletar Emily. "Emily" will receive the Liebers Trophy for her highest living lifetime milk record and the Arnold Knight Award recognizing her as the highest living lifetime protein producer.

"Emily" was born June 19, 1980. She was bred by Michael and Nancy Bingham and Family, Plainfield, Iowa, and is owned by Pamela Walther Arnold of Waverly, Iowa.

A Maurana Wis Teletar daughter, "Emily" has living life-

time production totals of 211,380 pounds of milk, 8,287 pounds of butterfat, and 7,227 pounds of protein. She was appraised Very Good-88 at 12-09.

Level Gold Deacons Elna tops the living lifetime butterfat list and will receive the Valley Set Award recognizing the highest lifetime butterfat producer. "Elna" was born Jan. 8, 1979. She was bred by the late Eugene Jensen, Amery, Wisconsin and is owned by Lyle Jensen of Amery, Wisconsin. "Elna," a Lyrene Wistar Deacon daughter, has living lifetime production totals of 186,990 pounds of milk, 9,676 pounds of butterfat and 6,980 pounds of protein. She was appraised Excellent-91 and 9-08. She also ranks second on the living lifetime production list for pounds of protein.

Berryman Farm D Nell ranks second on the living lifetime pro-

duction list for pounds of milk. "Nell" has living lifetime production totals of 194,390 pounds of milk, 7,306 pounds of butterfat and 6,247 pounds of protein. This Excellent-90 Berryman Farm Diamond daughter is bred and owned by John Stuart Berryman of Nicholasville, Kentucky.

Up The Creek Extras Alice ranks second for pounds of butterfat on the living lifetime production list. This Excellent-90 Hornback Farm Prince Extra daughter is bred and owned by Glen Anderson of Lester Prairie, Minnesota. "Alice" has living lifetime production totals of 183,930 pounds of milk, 8,373 pounds of butterfat and 6,105 pounds of protein.

To be considered for living lifetime production awards, the cow must be living on Dec. 31 of the preceding year and been in production on official test during a portion of the year.

# Top Guernsey Herds

REYNOLDSBURG, Ohio — The American Guernsey Association is to recognize commercial herds at the National Guernsey Convention in LaCrosse, Wisconsin.

The AGA will recognize the top herd for energy corrected milk that is at least one and one-half times larger than the average size herd on the Total Performance Evaluation (TPE) program. In 1996, the average TPE herd was 40 cows; therefore, to be recognized for the 1996 commercial herd award, there must be at least 60 complete lactations in the herd. This award recognizes both TPE and non-TPE herds of registered Guernseys.

The commercial herd award is sponsored by the New York Guernsey Breeders' Cooperative and began in 1995. The top commercial herd for 1996 is owned by David Vanden Heuvel of Black Creek, Wisconsin. The 61 cows

that comprise Spring Flo Guernsey Farm have an average of 18,759 pounds of milk, 880 pounds of butterfat and 642 pounds of protein, with an energy corrected milk average of 22,153 pounds.

The Dennis Nelson herd of Hillmar, California, receives second place honors, with an energy corrected average of 21,006 pounds. The 73 cows on Nells Glow Guernsey Farm had a 1996 lactation average of 18,094 pounds of milk, 816 pounds of butterfat and 628 pounds of protein.

The partnership of Millie Widmann and Axel Linde own the 74 cows that rounds out the top three herds for the 1996 commercial herd award. The Lindenhof herd of Oxford, Pennsylvania, had a lactation average of 18,153 pounds of milk, 811 pounds of butterfat and 624 pounds of protein, and an energy corrected milk average of 20,931 pounds.

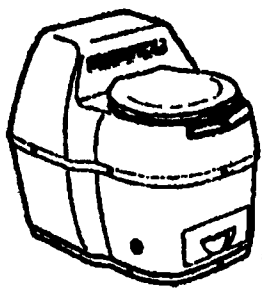
