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7. Judging will be in two parts. On Tuesday beginning at noon, samples will be judged on the basis of visual characteristics and tested for chemical analysis. On Wednesday at 9:00 a.m., the samples will be judged on the basis of visual and chemical characteristics.

8. Unless disapproved by the exhibitor, samples will be stored for exhibit in the Hay Show at the 1998 Pennsylvania Farm Show
