Where were you on July 20, 1969? Two men, Neil Armstrong and Edwin Aldrin Jr., were walking on the surface of the Moon. President Richard M. Nixon, in a moment of national pride, proclaimed it the greatest moment since Creation. The Apollo II mission had answered President John F. Kennedy's earlier State of the Union challenge, in 1961, to safely send a person to the Moon and back before the end of the decade. In the next Apollo landing (November 1969), Charles "Pete" Conrad Jr. referred to Neil Armstrong's statement, "That's one small step for [a] man, one giant leap for mankind," by saying, "Man, that may have been a small step for Neil, but that's a long one for me."

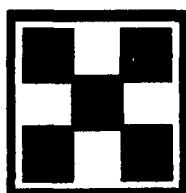
