HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — The Chesapeake Bay Foundation (CBF) strongly and enthusiastically supports statements made recently by Senator Robert C. Jubelirer calling for comprehensive, statewide standards for corporate hog farming operations according to a news release Thursday.

In addition, CBF believes that a moratorium on new, large animal operations in Pennsylvania is a reasonable and essential interim measure until the statewide standards that Jubelirer called for are in place. CBF believes these standards should include ground and surface water monitoring, siting criteria, regular inspections at the facilities, assurance of adequate land for manure application, and manure storage standards that protect water quality and public health.

"Pennsylvania is totally unprepared for an influx of these large animal operations. Farming operations of this magnitude are not adequately covered by current and pending environmental protection

programs," said Lamonte Garber, Agricultural Policy Specialist for CBF. "These corporate operations not only pose a threat to water quality, but also threaten the viability of small and mid-sized livestock farms," said Garber.

"Goals established by EPA and the Chesapeake Bay states to stem the flow of nutrients to the Bay by the year 2000 are already in jeopardy and are further threatened by an increase in factory farming operations," said Jolene E.

Chinchilli, PA Executive Director for CBF.

"We commend Senator Jubelirer for responding to citizens' concerns about corporate farms in Pennsylvania. We encourage the inclusion of locally affected citizens, family farm and sustainable agriculture interests, and environmental and public health interests in any statewide process to address this important issue," said Chinchilli.
