

Dairymen's Association Rewards Knowledge

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — The top winner in the Pennsylvania All-American Dairy Show's Junior Dairy Management Contest will receive \$1,000 this year for the first time, according to Dr. Carl Brown, contest chairman. "The Pennsylvania Dairymen's Association will contribute the \$1,000 award to recognize the knowledge and skill necessary to win this comprehensive contest. This is a tremendous addition, and a wonderful show of support," Brown added.

The Pennsylvania All-American Dairy Show will be held September 22-25 at the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg. The dairy management contest is scheduled for Tuesday, September 23.

David R. Smith, executive secretary for the Pennsylvania Dairymen's Association, said, "The Association wants to support activities that promote and enhance the dairy industry. This is a top notch contest that really exemplifies the variety of skills and information dairy farmers must demonstrate to be successful. We are very pleased to support the contest in this way."

Contestants are tested on their knowledge of dairy heifer judg-

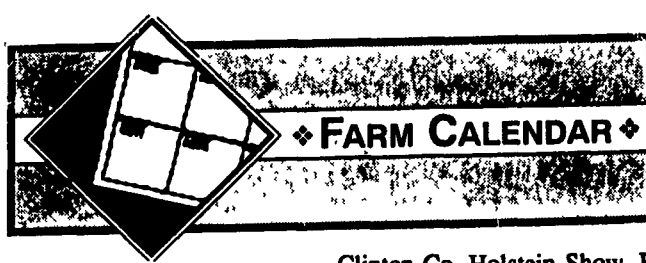
ing, linear trait and pedigree analysis, meats identification, grain forage identification and nutrition, farm and food safety, dairy cow food and leg health, and farm business management.

Last year 70 young people participated in the contest, which is open to all 4-H and FFA members.
