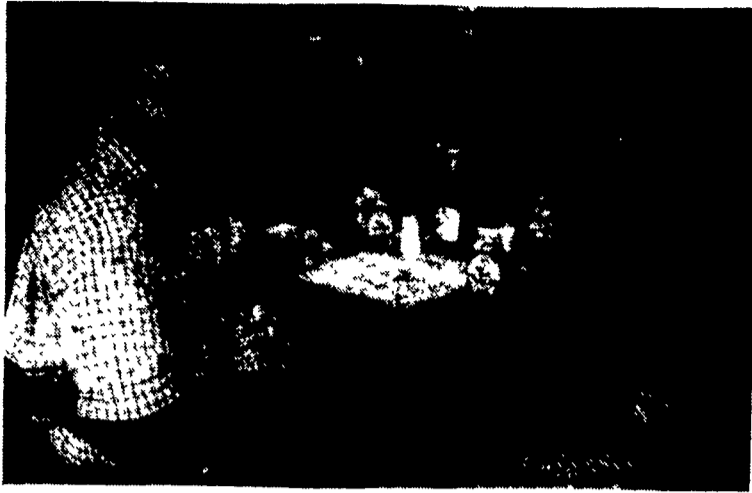


Faces At The Lebanon Area Fair

Two-year-old Dalton Carl Kalbach of Lebanon dressed for the fair. He is the grandson of Carl Kalbach, a bull rider at the competition.



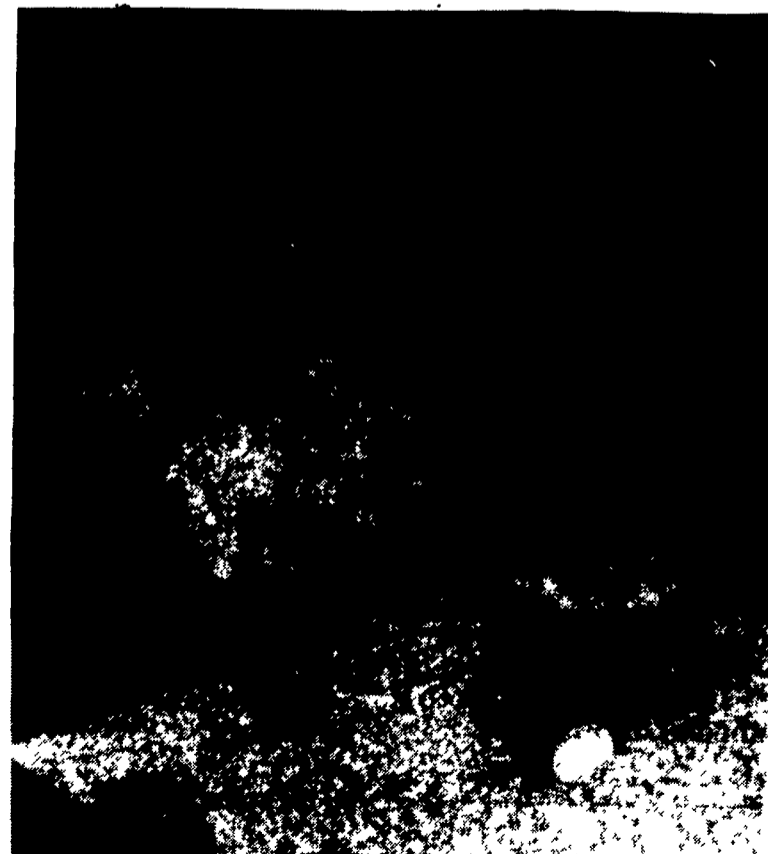
Discussing the mucky weather on Monday night, Mike Firestine remarked that he wouldn't be able to wait for a Saturday night bath this week.
