Compared to last week: Feeder steers and steer calves steady to 2.00 lower. Feeder heifers and heifer calves 1.00-3.00 lower. Demand light to moderate. Quality of supply plain to average. Weigh-ups average to full. Flesh conditions some better than last week with bulk of supply in medium condition. Upward movement in the corn market the past few weeks has cooled demand as the bumper harvest and cheap cost of gains have become questionable. Slaughter cows 1.50-2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 1.00 lower. Demand light to moderate. Trade less active as cow numbers have increased at Texas slaughter plants. Total of 450 cows and bulls sold with 70 percent to packers. Receipts this week 10,000; last week 12,632; last year 6,843. Supply consisted of 76 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 19 percent calves under 600 lbs; 5 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis. 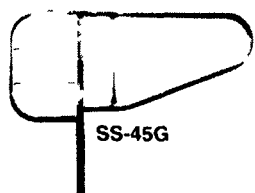
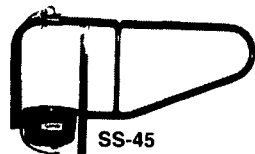

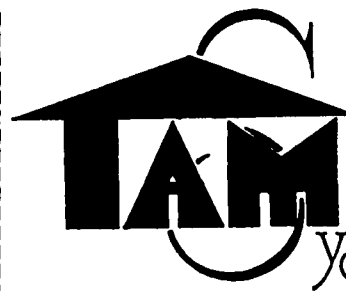
