Formula Helps Youth Determine Break-Even Costs

CALDWELL, Ohio - A simple mathematical formula can help youth understand the economics behind market livestock projects, according to an Ohio State University 4-H youth development specialist.

The high prices paid for grand

champion animals has made winnning synonymous with profit, said Chuck Bell. In some cases, that's translated into people paying everhigh prices for project animals without regard to basic economics.

Before buying an animal, youth

and parents need to understand how the purchase price affects any potential profit or loss, Bell said. To teach this information, Bell and colleague David Miller, a farm management specialist at Ohio State, devised a series of materials that help people easily

calculate the possibility of making profit, or at least breaking even.

Separate handouts for steers, feeder pigs and lambs chart the necessary sale price per pound, given the purchase price of the animal, feed and miscellaneous needs. The handout also provides the tormula — total costs divided by finished weight of the animal equals break-even sale price --- so youth can figure their own breakeven point. The same information is incorporated into a hands-on, three dimensional exhibit.

"Advisers and parents can use the teaching materials to help youth understand potential profits and potential risks of raising animals," Bell said. "It's partly economics and partly awareness of what you are willing to spend. And, it's one way to refocus market livestock projects on responsibility, proper husbandry practices, and the business of raising animals."

This information was presented at the national meeting of the American Society of Animal Science, held July 28 to Aug. 1 in Nashville, Tenn.
