

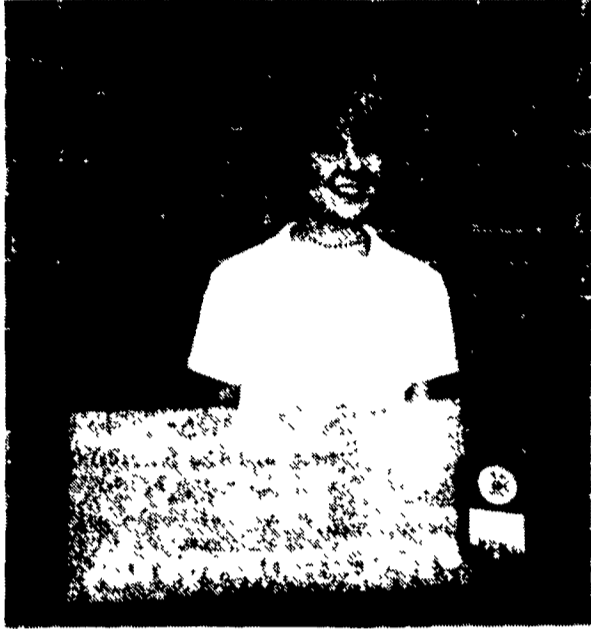
Youth Talent Abundant At Recent 4-H Achievement Days

The following photos identify these outstanding 4-H members by contest, from left to right.



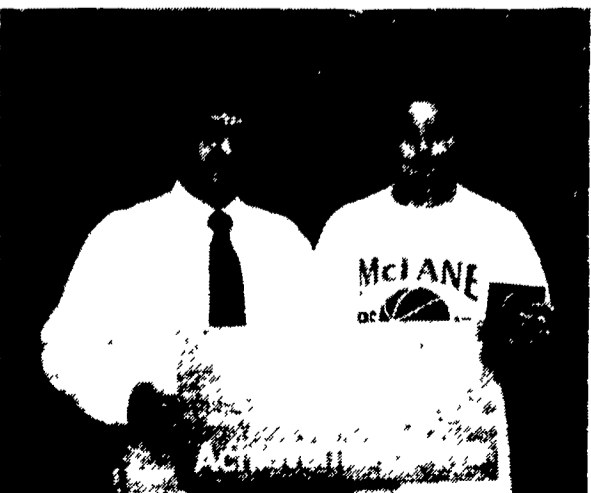
Air Pistol junior first place individual is Jamie Young from York County.



Air Pistol junior first place team members from Northumberland County are Trina Pelfer, Levi Spang, and Abigail Troutman (not pictured).



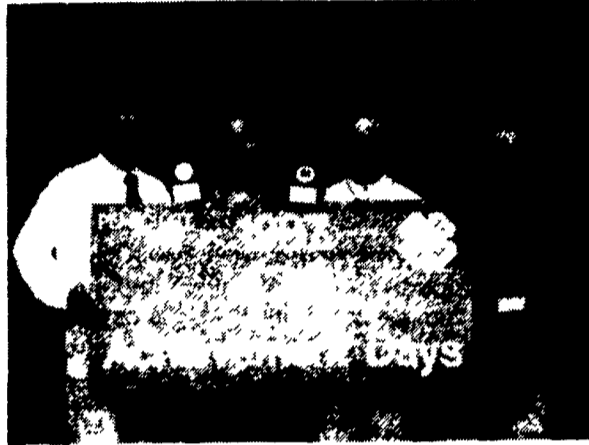
Air Pistol senior first place team members from Montour County are Ashley Smith, Brooke Vegh, and Adam Bergenstock (high individual).

Air Rifle junior first place team members from Montgomery County are Jeff Buckman, Bill Buckman, Andrew Crozler, and their coach Ed Feeley.



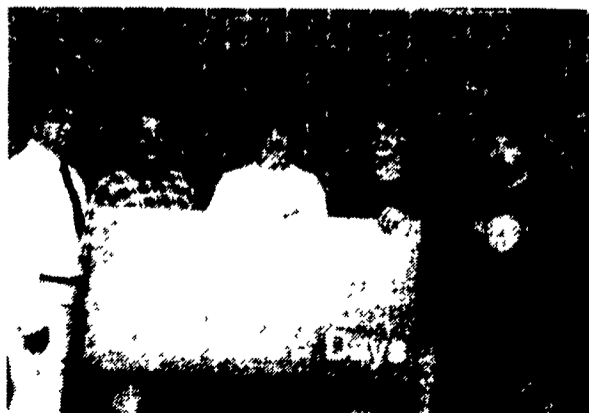
Air Rifle senior first place team members from Erie County are Stacey King, Paul Wade, and Randy Chapman.



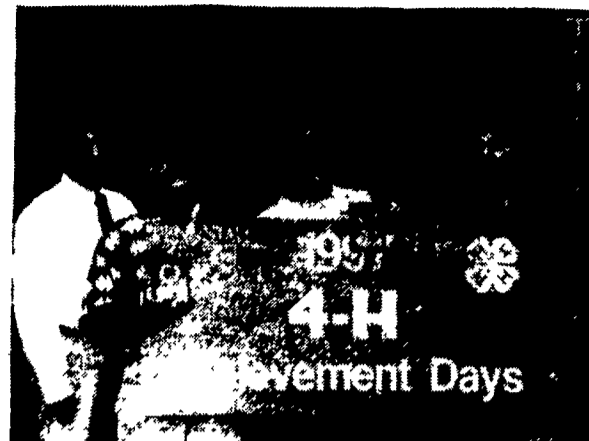
Orienteering beginners first place team members from Chester County are Jeff Fuddy, Heather Scotland, and James Scotland (high individual).



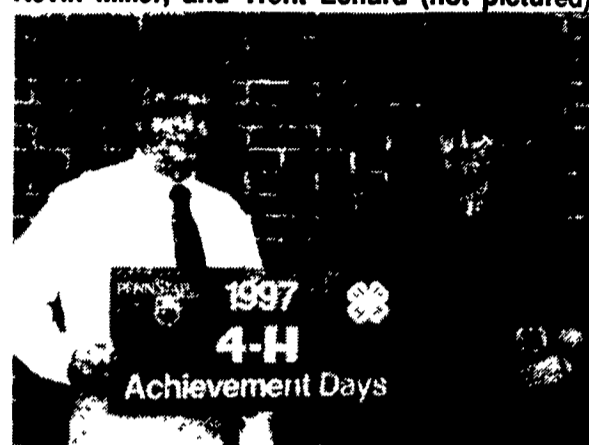
Orienteering advanced first place team members are Kevin Martin from Northampton County and Chris Erickson (high individual) from Montgomery County with coach Ed Feeley.



Archery junior first place team members from Somerset County are Matt Pyle (high individual), Kelly Courtney, David Miller, and Patrick Courtney.



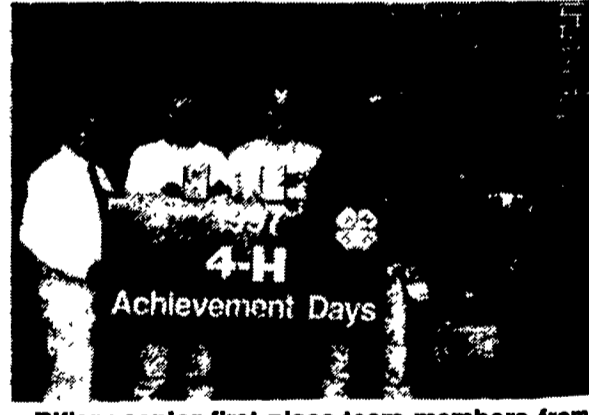
Archery senior first place team members from Somerset County are Chad Clark, Adam Ocasek, Kevin Miller, and Trent Echard (not pictured).



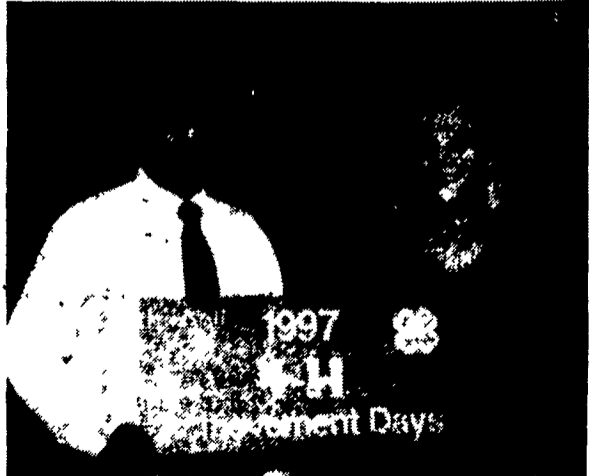
Riflery junior first place individual is Sam Dubs from Cumberland County.
