

# Field Day Held To Show New Technology

MT JOY (Lancaster Co.) - Under the trademark name of Maximizer Technology, Hoffman Seeds, Inc., held a field day Thursday to showcase all their latest technology that is offered to the industry.

Jeffery Cunningham, director of sales, said, "A lot of new technology is hitting agriculture right now, and we think it is important that people have the opportunity to view these things and become educated as to what they will do for them."

Cunningham listed BT technology for borer resistance in corn, round-up ready corn and beans, alfalfa leafhopper resistance, and high oil corn that is higher in ener-

gy and is a value added product. Bob Rich, director of marketing, said their sales season is just beginning with wheat, and the outlook is for a good marketing season in corn and soybeans, as well as the supporting products. Hoffman has an advantage in that they research products in the Northeast and see how these products perform in their own back yard. After they make evaluations as to the feasibility of a product, they also then look if it is profitable for the farmer.

The annual field day was held just east of town along the Mt. Joy/Manheim road. More than 300 farmers were expected at the event which was scheduled to last until 7 p.m.
