THIRD PLACE --- \$100 The First Place winner will then represent PA and the PFGC at the 1998 American Forage and Grassland Council Conference in Indianapolis, IN on March 8-11, 1998 in the N. America Forage Spokesperson Contest. AFGC conference and travel expenses will be covered



by the PFGC. All participants in the AFGC contest will receive an honorarium and the first three place winners will receive cash awards and plaques. The Second Place winner in the PFGC contest will serve as the alternate from PA.

The PFGC and AFGC contests will be run and judged using the same rules and scoring procedures. Talks must be no longer than ten minutes in length. Judges will then ask the spokesperson questions about their farm operation for an additional two minutes. 


