main reasons they are on a production testing program. Income over feed costs and other financial information ranked low. Nearly half of the respondents use a personal computer as a means of managing farm information.

Responding to the question regarding having one representative for both production testing and AI sales while maintaining the AI and DHI cooperatives separate, two-thirds said they would favor such an arrangement. The commentary provided with the answer to this question provided some conflicting views. While the overwhelming majority said they favored one representative if service costs could by better contained through consolidation of services, others expressed concern about a conflict of interest.
