# *Exports* Present Bonus


DENVER, Colo. - Beef exports in 1996 increased by 3 percent over 1995's record export volume — a significant bonus for American cattle producers and allied industries last year, according to a recent study by CF Resources, an independent research firm in Denver, Colo.

Export sales of U.S beef and beef variety meats, the study show, were responsible for 12.4 percent of the wholesale value of total U.S. beef production last year --- down slightly from 12.7 percent in 1995, but three times the figure of just 10 years ago.

The study finds that U.S. cattle prices benefit substantially from increased demand for highquality, grain-fed U.S. beef in foreign markets. Given production levels and demand last year in the United States, export sales of U.S. beef in 1996 added \$110.06 per head to the value of fed cattle, \$105 per head to feeder cattle, and \$99.70 per head to calves.
