The crowing touch to our 25 years of intensive selection was the record breaking performance of the 14 bulls consigned to the Profit Maker Test in Ogallala, Nebraska 1996-97, the top bull bringing \$5000 with an average of \$2900 on all bulls. For the last 8 years the nutritional management of the herd has been one of intensive rotational grazing for 7 months of the year and haylage and hay for the balance of the year
