

Ayrshire Wins Colored Breed Junior Supreme

YORK (York Co.) — Jason Stambaugh has won lots of breed champion titles as a junior Ayrshire exhibitor, but last week he copped a brand new award. The 16-year-old East Berlin 4-H'er's senior 3-year-old was selected supreme champion of the colored breed show, the first such honor ever bestowed at the York Fair's junior dairy show.

Don-Sher Astro Anne was selected from a lineup of five breed champions by show judge Mary Creek, a Maryland dairyman and purebred cattle breeder. She praised the young cow's beautiful udder and adept handling of her legs and feet while on the move. Anne is milking in her 2nd lactation and projected to 18,000 pounds. This is the second show season that Stambaugh has had her in his show lineup; earlier in the season she was both the county roundup and district show breed champion.

A close second mention went to the Guernsey champion, Rutter Bros Perfectos Lydia, exhibited by Terri Johnson, York. Judge Creek praised the senior 2-year-old growth and stretch and noted that the younger cow displayed a nearly perfect udder.

Other breed champions in contention were Wind Mill Hammer Colleen, the Brown Swiss senior 3-year-old exhibited by Nathan Hostetter, Dover, Jersey senior 2-year-old champion Franken Theodore Ulli, exhibited by Suzann Pomraning, Delta, and the dry cow Milking Shorthorn champion, Joy-El Erica, exhibited by Heather Crowl, Airville.

NEW VARIETIES FOR 1998

Gardeners are looking for new plants every year. Here are new flowers and vegetables that are featured in 1998 mail order seed catalogs, seed packets or as bedding plants at garden centers. This is the third in a series.

Bean 'Marseille French Filet' is prized for its slender, 4 to 5-inch long pods. This is an easy grow, gourmet variety with excellent disease resistance and heat tolerance. Bush Habit.

Carrot 'Bolina' is a golf-ball sized carrot with sweet flavor and deep red-orange color. Its round shape makes it ideal for growing in soils too heavy for other carrots.

Carrot 'Sweet Sunshine' is a lemon-yellow carrot that is unexcelled for fresh eating with a juicy, tender crunch. Its sweet luscious flavor and texture make for refreshing snacks on vegetable platters and in salads. It will forever change how you think about carrots 70-72 days.

Cucumber 'Six Hybrid' has thin skin, sweet flavor, too, even up to a full size. No need to peel — ideal for the relish tray. Best if grown on trellises to protect the delicate skin against scarring.

Onion 'Candy Hybrid' — If there is an onion variety that is adapted everywhere for spring planting, this is it. This 'mid-day'

onion does well in north, south and points in between. Unique, sweet, mild flavor; extreme early maturity and jumbo to colossal bulb sizes add up to make this the best new golden yellow onion ever for home gardening.

Pepper 'Gold Standard' Hybrid is huge 5"x5" blocky, bell peppers mature to a glossy, deep golden yellow. Aromatic and extra-sweet when ripened to full yellow, and excellent in the green stage. Delicious raw, grilled, stuffed or roasted — 73 days from transplant for green, 88 days for yellow.

Pepper 'Mucho Nacho' Hybrid A new jumbo sized jalapeno with fruits an inch longer than standard jalapenos. They're also fatter and heavier, and even somewhat hotter. Great for stuffing and big nacho slices.

Squash 'Starship' is a new Hybrid scallop squash that has consistently delivered high yields of eye-catching, flavorful fruit for home gardeners. This variety's medium to dark-green fruit have a refined scallop shape, small blossom scar, and high gloss which adds to their appeal. An open bush has made the fruit easy to harvest.
