frost Many farmers overwinter their parsnips in the garden for early spring harvest, but some cooks say it's best to keep them in moist sand in the root cellar, so their middles won't turn woody. 2-1/2 cups water 1/2 teaspoon salt

2 large carrots, scraped and sliced 8 small parsnips, scraped

1 bay leaf




