WAYNESBORO (Franklin Co.) — What does corn have to do with car tires and why is it on display in a hardware store?

That's the question customers asked Beck and Benedict Hardware Store owners Dick and Della Baschert in Waynesboro.

In the summer, the Bascherts set up a display of corn uses in the glass exhibit cases in front of their hardware store as part of the 200th year anniversary of Waynesboro.

Corn is an important crop to Franklin County, which plants about 100,000 acres of the crop at a value of \$29 million.

For tires, corn oil and other products are used to help remove tires, when they are manufactured, from presses.

In the display, browsers found out there were more than 3,500 products made from

see how much carbon dioxide is taken out of the air by an acre of corn, as well as how much oxygen is produced.

ST. LOUIS, Mo. — Kevin Aandahl joins the staff of the National Corn Growers Association (NCGA) as director of communications.

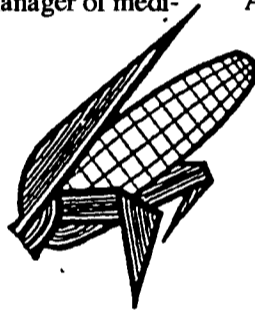
Prior to joining NCGA, Aandahl was manager of medi-

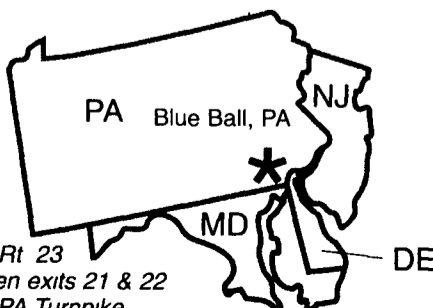

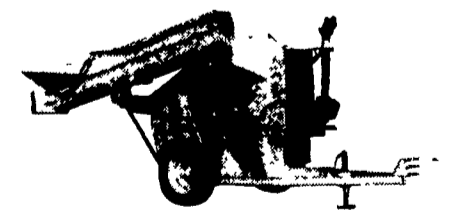
