PORK PIE

- 1 recipe plain pastry
- 2 pounds lean pork, cubed
- 2 1/4 cups pork stock or water
- 1/2 teaspoon salt, to taste
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 cup diced carrots
- 2 cups diced potatoes
- 1/2 cup diced onions

Brown cubes of pork in fat. Add stock or water, salt, and bay leaf. Cover and cook slowly for 40 minutes. Remove bay leaf and add carrots, potatoes, and onions. Cook for 20 minutes or until vegetables are tender. Transfer mixture to casserole dish. Cover dish with pastry. Bake in hot oven at 450 degrees for 20 minutes or until browned. Serves 6 to 8.

MAPLE-MUSTARD-GLAZED PORK ROAST

- 2 pound boneless pork loin roast
 - 1/2 cup maple syrup
 - 3 tablespoons Dijon-style mustard
 - 2 tablespoons cider vinegar
 - 2 tablespoons soy sauce
 - Salt and pepper; to taste
- Stir together maple syrup, mustard, vinegar, soy sauce, salt and pepper. Spread evenly over pork roast and place in shallow pan. Roast pork in a 350 degree oven for about 45 minutes to 1 1/4 hours until internal temperature, measured with a meat thermometer, reaches 160 degrees. Remove roast from oven and let rest 10 minutes before slicing to serve.
