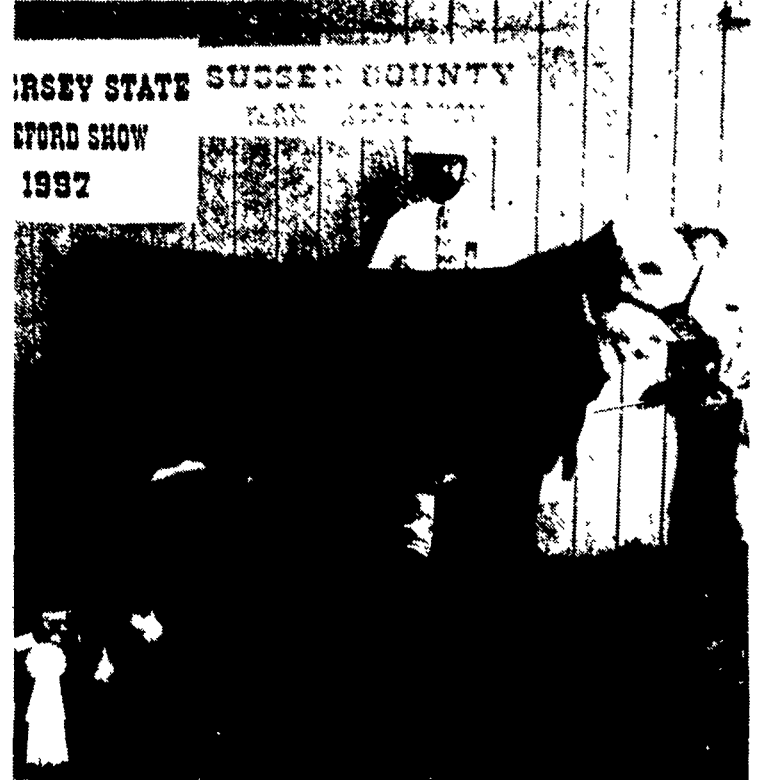

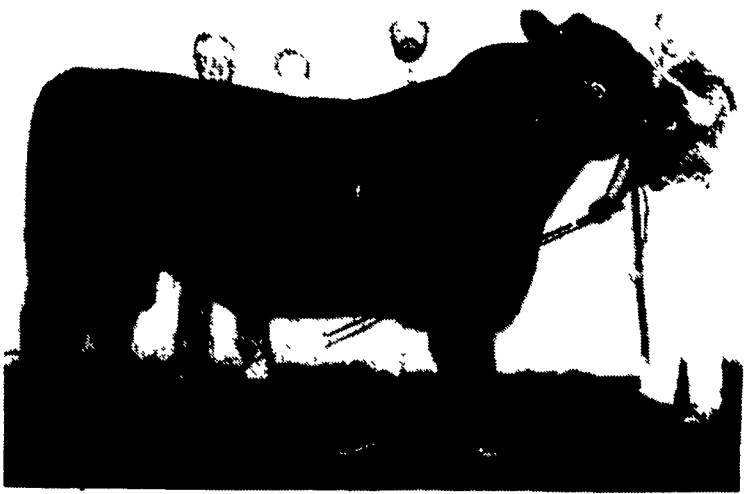

Department Offers Grants to Youth Organizations

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Rural youth organizations may apply for direct grants of up to \$2,500 to fund their educational projects and activities, Agriculture Secretary Samuel E. Hayes Jr. announced. The deadline for applications is Dec. 5.

"Our youth are the future of agriculture, and we're pleased to offer these grants under the Agricultural and Rural Youth Organization Grant Program," Hayes said. "The grants help these organizations expand activities that increase knowledge and awareness of issues specific to rural areas."

A total of \$50,000 is available for the grant program, which is funded by proceeds from a trust fund through the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Since 1992, six previous rounds of funding have been distributed.

Grants can be used by organizations such as 4-H and FFA to fund educational projects, programs, seminars, or field trips designed to increase awareness of agricultural and rural issues. Applications must be postmarked by Dec. 5 to be considered.

Recipients will be selected by the 13-member Agriculture and Rural Youth Grant Board, which

includes representatives from the Agriculture Department, Education Department, the Pennsylvania Rural Electric Association, a vocational-agriculture teacher, the Pennsylvania State University's Cooperative Extension, 4-H, FFA, the Pennsylvania State Grange, the Pennsylvania Council of Cooperatives, and the General Assembly.
