Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was seasonally slow. Seller offerings were adequate or available and extra supplies were difficult to place. Live supplies were at least moderate; weights varied in a range of light to heavy. Processing schedules were reduced or curtailed in several instances and were very light in total. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 48 to 62 cents. Trade sentiment was steady at best.

In the parts complex, wings and gizzards were in best demand and supplies cleared satisfactorily. Other items were fully adequate or available to a limited buying interest.
