Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers 1.00-2.00 higher. Steer and heifer calves steady to 2.00 higher. Demand good for all classes. Quality plain to average, few attractive. Feeder cattle in medium to moderate flesh; calves in medium to modest flesh. Weigh-ups mostly average. Slaughter cows steady to 1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 1.00 lower. Packer demand moderate to good with best action from southern buyers. 685 cows and bulls sold with 65 percent to packers. Receipts this week 6,750; last week 8,794; last year 5,583. Supply consisted of 43 percent year-lings and few calves over 600 lbs; 47 percent calves under 600 lbs; 10 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.


