4-H State Winners Attend **National Conference**

Six state winners were selected to represent Delaware in the annual National 4-H Congress, held in Memphis, Tenn., from Nov. 28 to Dec. 2.

The trip was awarded to recognize outstanding 4-H youth and build skills in leadership and community service More than 1,000 youths, age 14 to 19, attended the conference, which included educational seminars, multi-cultural events and service projects. Participants representing 48 states and two territories had the opportunity to participate in a nationally televised town hall meeting that explored issues facing today's youth. The theme of this year's Congress was "Learning to Lead, Leading to Learn in a Diverse World.

Fifteen-year-old Lindsay Armstrong, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Armstrong of Wilmington, won the sate award for leadership. A student at Ursuline Academy, she has held leadership positions in Junior Council and in her 4-H club, the Highlanders.
