Prices were unchanged to lower for the large sizes on the East Coast, and unchanged for the balance of prices. The market tone was steady to weak. Demand was mixed across the full range and was best where pre-holiday features were present. Supplies of all sizes were at least adequate with occasional shortages of graded sizes; ungraded supplies remained adequate to ample. Breaking stock supplies were adequate to ample and offerings increased for the light demand; prices were lower. Light type hen offerings were at least adequate for full processing schedules.

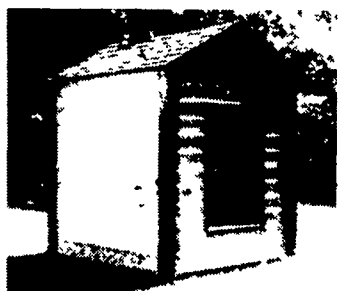

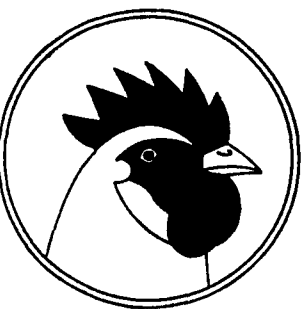
