## **Sheep To Shawl Contest Winners Announced**

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) Pennsylvania's First Lady Michele M. Ridge opened the 82nd Pennsylvania Farm Show's Sheep to Shawl contest, and enjoyed the work of the four teams with son Tom.

The Butler County Peddlers got off to a delayed start when there was a misunderstanding of the starting time and their shearer was not there on time. Finding a substitute shearer cost them time, but in the end they won first place in the contest and the "Weaver's Award" for the creativity of the design, use of color and skill. They were second in last year's contest.

The shawl was auctioned by Harry Bachman for \$375. All four shawls were modeled by Elizabeth Lee Hayes, wife of Agriculture Secretary Samuel E. Hayes Jr., who welcomed the participants.


Second place went to the Pennsylvania Mohair & Cashmere Growers Association who were the first to complete a shawl. This is the second year they competed, having won first place in 1997. Their shawl also brought \$375 at the auction. They received the "Spinner's Award" in recognition of the quality of their workmanship and spinner's team spirit and cooperation. In a vote by contest participants for their favorite, they also received the "Team's Choice" award.

Third place went to the Woolie and Wild Spinners & Weavers, who also received the "Shearer's Award" for careful handling of the sheep and exceptional skill. The shawl made by the group consisted of all Dauphin County wool. It was recognized to be of the highest quality wool and received the "Best Fleece Award." It was auctioned for \$175.

Weave Made It produced the fourth place shawl, which was auctioned for \$250.

Each team is composed of a shearer, a weaver, and three spinners who competed to craft a quality homemade shawl from start to finish. In order to participate in the Farm Show, the team members must all be Pennsylvania residents and have competed or exhibited at two events prior to the Farm

The purpose of the Sheep to Shawl contest is to promote public awareness of the contributions made by the sheep and wool industry to Pennsylvania agriculture. It also provides an opportunity for craftspeople in the state to showcase their skills. Originally established in 1981 as the Northeastern Regional competition, the Sheep to Shawl contest has been held annually at the Pennsylvania Farm Show, drawing crowds as large as 5,000 people. The competition is sponsored by the Pennsylvania Sheep and

Wool Growers Association and is supported by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture and the Farm Show Commission.

Three judges evaluated the teams and scored them on the basis of shearing, speed, uniformity of yarn being spun, overall design of the weaving and team identification.

When evaluating team identification, the judges looked for an original theme or creative name that unified the individual members of the teams.

The shearing portion of the contest was judged according to speed, uniformity of shearing, lack of cuts to the sheep, and lack of second cuts, or small nicks, to

Evaluation of the three spinners individually was based on fleece preparation and how their individual spining related to the overall design of the shawl.

The design and appearance of the finished shawl were judged on originality of design, difficulty of

the weaver, softness and drapability of the shawl, lack of pull-in in the selvage edges, color coordination between warp and weft, and the quality of the finished fringe.

The completed shawl was also judged for evenness in weaving as well as evenness and lack of pullins in the selvage edges. The rules require the shawl to be at least 22 inches wide and 78 inches in length. Teams were awarded bonus points for how quickly they finished the shawl.
