

Wheat, No. 2 — 3.225 bu., 5.386 cwt.
Barley, No. 3 — 2.358 bu., 5.045 cwt.
Oats, No. 2 — 1.723 bu., 5.374 cwt.
Soybeans, No. 1 — 6.513 bu., 10.876 cwt.
Ear Corn — 82.48 ton, 4.12 cwt.
Alfalfa Hay — 169.25 ton, 8.463 cwt.
Mixed Hay — 144.25 ton, 7.212 cwt.
Timothy Hay — 146.25 ton, 7.312 cwt.
