many programs you can read about in the annual report," he said.

Gary Dean presented a treasurer's report. Through county appropriations, total income for the year was \$412,043.53, of which 5,208.94 came in interest payments.

Dr. Michelle Rodgers, regional director for Penn State Cooperative Extension, spoke about the "seamless organization" that is Penn State, and Penn State's efforts to provide the full resources of the university to bear on a wide range of problems. She spoke about a vegetable grower in an adjacent county that received technical assistance through the PEN-NTAP program at Penn State.

Two county extension agents were recognized by Rodgers for their work and commitment to cooperative extension. They were Leon Ressler, county environmen-

tal issues agent, for 10 years, and Chet Hughes, livestock agent, for 15 years of service.

New directors were also elected. They are Larry G. Baum, Elizabethtown, for the northwest area. Baum with wife Norma and children Nathaniel and Linda operates a poultry farm and was graduated from Delaware Valley College with a bachelor's in animal husbandry. In the northeast, John N. Rohrer, Lancaster, operates a dairy with wife Bonnie and children Ryan, Monica, Jessica, and Jason.

In the southwest, newly elected director is Richard Rohrer, Lancaster. In the southeast, new director is Virginia Ranck, Paradise. Serving the southern district is Curtis E. Akers, Quarryville, who operates a dairy with wife Ruth and children Gary, Donna, Linda, and Nancy.
