ANSWER - Fran Westfall, New Oxford, sent in this recipe for Shirtey Schwoerer.

Cheese Nuggets

1 pound mozzarella, Monterey Jack or cheddar cheese 1½ cups fine dry bread crumbs

1/4 cup flour

3 eggs, well beaten

Vegetable oil

cut cheese into 1-inch cubes. In bowl, combine bread crumbs and flour. Dip cheese into beaten eggs, then into bread crumb mixture; let stand a few minutes. Dip coated cheese into egg, then into bread crumb mixture again. Chill 10 minutes to set. Fill large fry pan about one-third full of vegetable oil. Heat to 375 degrees. Fry cheese quickly until golden brown, around 2 to 3 minutes; drain. Serve with one of the sauces below.

Dipping sauce: In small saucepan, combine 1 cup water, 6-ounce can tomato paste, 1 teaspoon instant minced onion. 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder, and 1 teaspoon sugar. Simmer 10 minutes. Add choice of one of the following: 1/4 teaspoon Italian herbs, or 1 teaspoon dill, or 1/2 teaspoon tarragon leaves.

Sweddish Meatballs

4 tablespoons chopped onion

1 cup mashed potatoes

3 tablespoons fine bread crumbs pound extra lean ground beef

1/3 cup whipping cream, unwhipped

1 teaspoon salt

Break the egg into a large mixing bowl, and beat lightly with a fork. Add all the other ingredients. Mix well. Shape into meatballs in the bottom of a flat pan. Bake at 400 degrees for 20 minutes or until browned. Remove meatballs with spatula onto serving platter and decorate with parsley.

Dash pepper


1 egg


