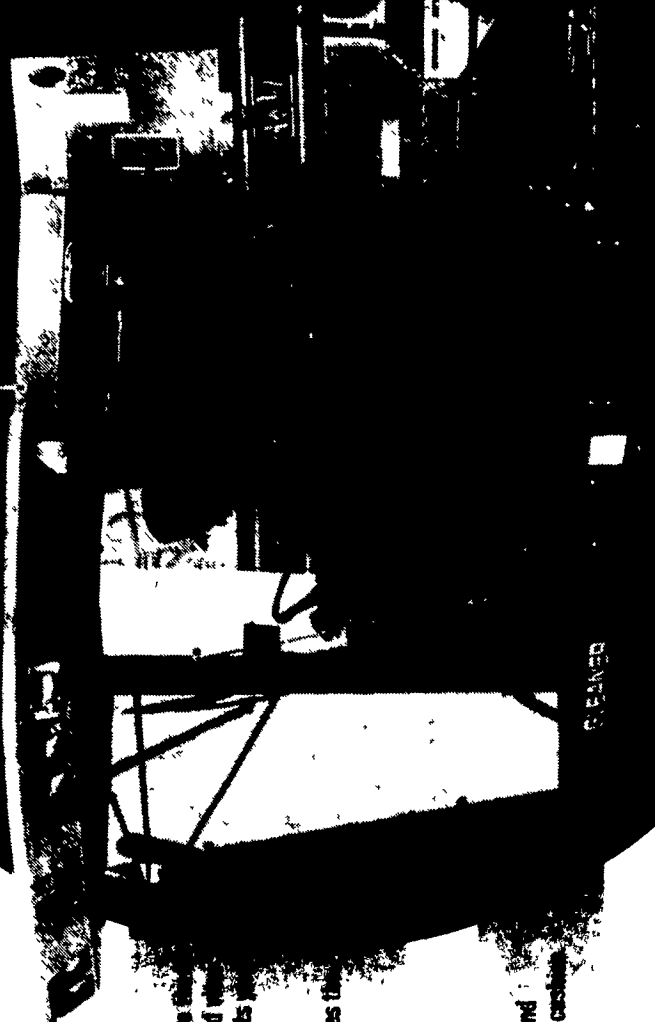

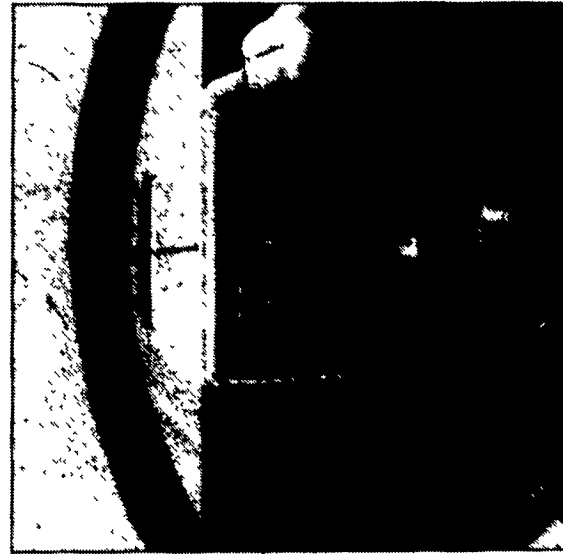

ture. You often take three steps forward and then three backwards. It's frustrating but of no use to get upset. Flexibility is the key word when working with other cultures," Rutt said.

"When you see the potential outcome, it helps to keep me

patient," Rutt said.

"It's a tremendous experience and challenge. If the program is successful, it will have impact upon all of West Africa. Even if I never go back again, the country now has the genetics that took hundreds of years for this country to develop,"

Rutt said.

Rutt's Nigerian venture is totally separate of the 4-H International Exchange Club.

A 4-H trip to Nigeria is completely out of the question because the U.S. has sanctions against Nigeria and it is not a safe place to visit.

However, Rutt has diplomatic immunity and finds the venture with the United Nations exciting.

The Rutts believe that working with other cultures is the key to

developing understanding between nations.

Those interested in joining the newly-formed International Exchange Club must meet the following criteria:

- must be 13 years old by Jan. 1 to join the club.
- must be 16 by Jan. 1 to travel.
- Must belong and be active in at least one other 4-H club.
- Must keep blue forms, scrapbooks, pictorial journals of 4-H

involvement.

• Must actively participate in meetings and fundraisers during hosting and travel years.
