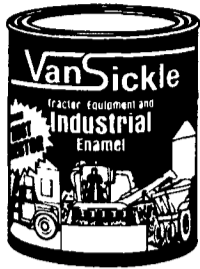

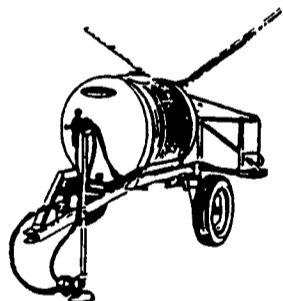

# Agricultural Innovation Expo Designed To Strengthen Safety Crop

BEL AIR, Md. — New agricultural tools and techniques may be making work easier and more productive for American farmers. But industry safety officials say these innovations must be handled with as much care by farmers today as their ancestors did with the horse and plow.

To help farmers and even weekend gardeners remain productive and safe, a free Harford County Agricultural Innovation and Safety Expo will be held March 28 from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. on the North Harford High School campus in Pylesville.

Manufacturers have been flooding the farming market in recent years with many new products to keep pace with the changing U.S. agricultural industry, according to Harford County Cooperative Extension Service Director Robert Halman. But if proper safety and operational procedures are left behind when these products are taken into the fields, the results can be tragic, he said.

"Although farmers are conscientious, things can be taken for granted," Halman said. "Unfortunately in the production of crops here, there have been some near fatal and fatal accidents."

The list of participants at the expo is growing every day. Along with the extension service, sponsors and demonstrators include Walter G. Coale - New Holland, Deer Creek Equipment - John Deere, Harford County Hazardous Materials Team, Whiteford Volunteer Fire Company Heaps Oil, Harford County Farm Credit, North Harford High School Future Farmers of America and

the Harford County Office of Economic Development.

"This is the first time Harford County will see a collection of agriculturally-related government agencies and private businesses coming together for such an event," said Agriculture Economic Development Planner John Sullivan III adding. "Whether you're someone whose family has farmed hundreds of acres for generations or someone who spends evenings and weekends tilling the soil in a home garden, you can benefit from attending this expo."

Exhibits will highlight some of the latest innovations in agricultural tools along with safety precautions which must be taken to prevent potentially fatal accidents. Proper operation of a hay baler, forage blower, sprayer equipment and combine will be demonstrated. Correctly handling livestock and providing animal safety will be covered by the FFA.

Other scheduled exhibits and displays include Safe Handling of Petroleum Products, Roll-Over Protective Structures, Livestock and Horse Trailer Safety, Electric Fence Safety, Farm Fires, Pesticide Spills,

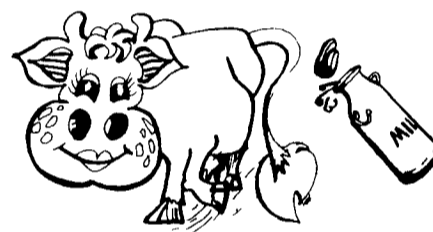
Greenhouse Maintenance and Mower Safety. Lunch items will be sold by FFA members.

Also at the expo, persons who have held a Private Pesticide Application license can be recertified through a 30-minute training program provided by the University of Maryland Cooperative Extension Service and the Maryland Department of Agriculture.

Whether it's improving an application technique; watching a new tool demonstration; or practicing new safety procedures around farm equipment and animals, everyone can learn something beneficial at the expo, according to Harford County Government Risk Manager and former Commercial Sprayer John Walter.

"From making sure you still read all of the manufacturer's warnings and instructions on a replacement model for an old farm implement before using it for the first time to buckling your safety belt on a tractor before you start it each time," Walter said, "it's all part of keeping you safe."
