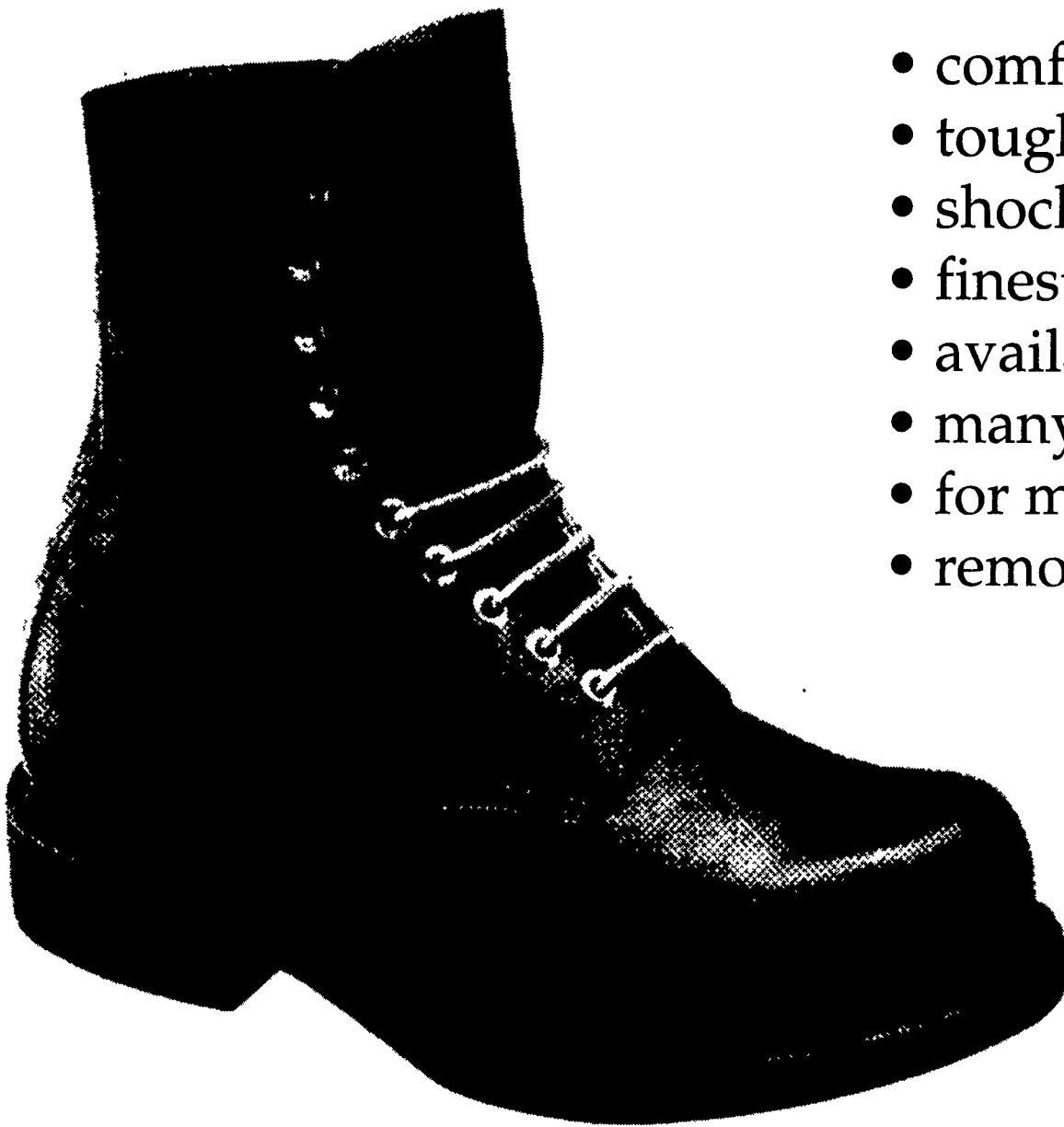
and Josh Dawson were first off-farm employment record books.
