

MAPLE SQUASH SOUFFLÉ

3 cups cooked winter squash (or 2 packages frozen squash, thawed) 1/4 cup milk 3 tablespoons flour 3 eggs, beaten 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg ground pepper, to taste 3 tablespoons maple syrup



1-quart casserole. Place immediately into a hot oven and bake about 35 minutes, until top is golden.


