office. One of the 10 chose to pay the assessment rather than face legal action. The Department is in process of filing civil complaints with a District Magistrate in Har-

risburg against the remaining growers.

Last year the Department of Agriculture obtained a judgment against one grower who had not paid the assessment for 1995. This has been turned over to an attorney for collection.

The Board intends to continue

its enforcement efforts. While the Board is reluctant to take fellow growers to court, they also feel it is their duty to the hundreds of growers who regularly pay their assessments. To allow other growers to ignore the assessment payment requirement is not fair and only encourages more non-compliance.

Northeast Dairy Compact Called Beneficial

ALBANY, N.Y. - Despite some reservations by a few people, the Northeast Interstate Dairy Compact has proven to be beneficial to a dairy farmers shipping milk into the New England states, including nearly 1,000 dairy farmers in New York and some producers in Pennsylvania.

However, according to the Progressive Ag Organization, Meshoppen, the continued and expanded success of the Compact depends on the State Assembly in Albany, New York.

The New York Senate has passed the needed legislation on a 35-15 vote to authorize New York State to join the compact. Now the endeavor is being focused on the New York Assembly. Every dairy farmer and all agri-business people in New York State should be urging their local assemblyman to support the Compact. In addition, everyone should contact the members of the Assembly in New York City and convince them to support the Compact.

Pennsylvania
Senator Noah Wenger, chairman of the Pennsylvania Senate Agriculture Committee, has announced that the Senate Ag Com-

mittee will hold a statewide hearing on Senate Bill 170. The Bill was introduced by Senator Roger Madigan from Bradford County. S-170 would allow Pennsylvania to join the Northeast Compact.

The hearing will be held on Friday, April 3 at the Penn College in Williamsport, PA beginning at 9 a.m. Penn College (formerly Williamsport Community College) is located on West Third Street.

Senator Wenger will be making an official announcement of the hearing in the near future.

ADADC Meeting

COLUMBUS, Ohio — Dairy farmers will learn more about their investment in product promotion at a kick-off barbecue during the 1998 Spring Dairy Expo.

The American Dairy Association & Dairy Council Mid East, the advertising and promotion organization funded by dairy farmers in Ohio, West Virginia and

western Pennsylvania, will host an annual meeting Thursday, April 2, in the George V. Voinovich Center at the Ohio Expo Center. The dinner will begin at 4 p.m. and is free to those in attendance.

ADADC Mid East will share with dairy farmers how their check-off dollars are making a difference for the dairy industry. Since the check-off program began in 1983, milk sales have increased by 27 percent. Per capita consumption has increased by 11.5 percent. That's an increase of 72 pounds more dairy products per person — triple the growth seen in the 12 years prior to the establishment of the national dairy promotion program! In addition, before the program began, the surplus of milk was 16.8 billion pounds. Since then, an additional 33 billion pounds of milk is being sold today!
