Since the check-off program began in 1983, milk sales have increased by 27 percent. Per capita consumption has increased by 11.5 percent. That's an increase of 72 pounds more dairy products per person triple the growth seen in the 12 years prior to the establishment of the nauonai dairy promotion program! 
