

PDPP Board Elects 1998 Officers

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — The Pennsylvania Dairy Promotion Program (PDPP) board elected 1998-99 officers at its Feb. 23 meeting in Harrisburg.

Richard C. Waybright, Gettysburg, was re-elected to serve a second one-year term as chairman

of the board. Waybright is the owner of Mason Dixon Farm.

Also re-elected as officers are John Ligo, Grove City, secretary; and Raymond Diebold, Altoona, treasurer. Newly elected was Dick Shellenberger, Manheim, to serve as vice chairman of PDPP.

Randall Meabon, Wattsburg, Tom Croner, Berlin, Karl Krock, Knoxville, and Rita Kennedy, Butler, also were elected to the executive committee.

In addition to the elections, the board approved its 1998 sponsorships. For the third consecutive

year the PDPP will sponsor events with the Erie Seawolves and Williamsport Cubs minor league baseball teams.

"We've selected sponsorships and activities that allow us to reach children 6-11 years old," says Cindy Weimer, spokesperson for PDPP. "We wanted local opportunities to show kids that milk is where they're at — the fun places like minor league baseball. Building on the 'got milk?' advertising campaign, we'll integrate the message into all of the events and promotions we conduct with the teams."

More than 300,000 baseball fans attend games in Erie and Wil-

liamsport throughout the baseball season. PDPP plans to give out more than 8,000 promotional items to kids at games and special events hosted by the two teams.

Other sponsorships include a third year as supporters of Tour de 'Toona bicycle race. The race takes place in July and travels through Altoona and State College.

PDPP contracts with the American Dairy Association & Dairy Council Mid East to implement advertising, marketing, promotion and nutrition education on behalf of dairy farmers in 33 counties in western and north-central Pennsylvania.

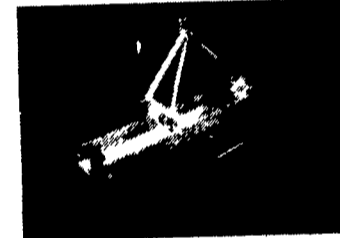

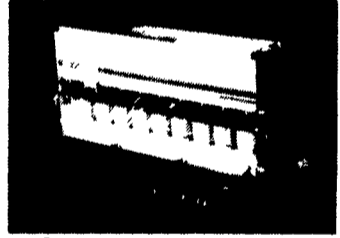
