ly Cattle Su Compared to last Feeder cattle and calves steady to 1.00 higher. Demand very good for all classes. Quality highly varied and plain thru attractive with increased supply of Texas crossbreds. Feeder cattle in slightly thin to moderate flesh. Stockers and calves in medium to many thin condition, few moderately fleshy new crop calves in supply. Weigh-ups gaunt to average, few full. Slaughter cows and bulls 2.00-3.00 higher. Packer very good for light receipts. Total of 265 cows and bulls sold with 50 percent going to packers. 125 bulls sold in special breeding bull sale. Receipts this week 7,900; last week 8,520; last year 8,903. Supply consisted of 72 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 23 percent calves under 600 lbs; 2 percent slaughter cows and bulls, 3 percent replacement cows and bulls for a total of 5 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

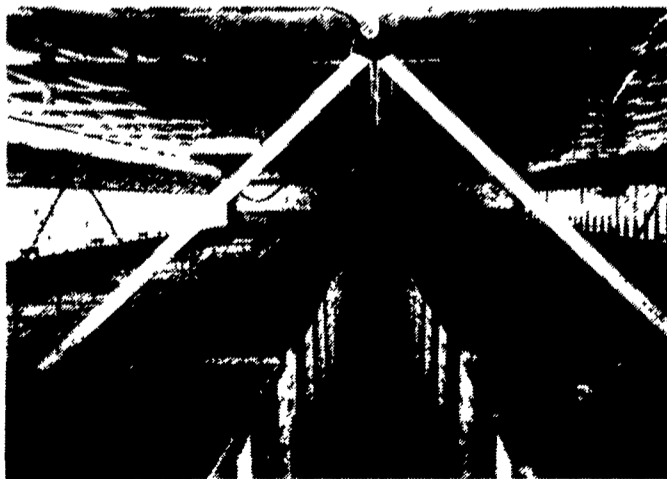

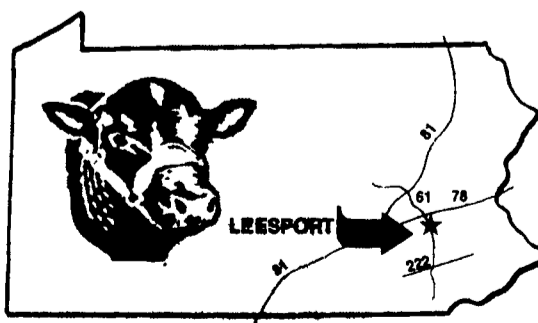
