

This past week I came across a scary, challenging quote about children. "What is done to children, they will do to society."

qualities to others in the next generation. Correspondingly, children who are neglected or hurt may pass on that hurt to others.

being Child Care Provider Appreciation Day. Child care providers, like elementary school teachers, high school instructors, and college professors are educators. Let's take time in the next few weeks to say a special thank you to people who work with young children in day cares, nursery schools, Sunday School classrooms, playground groups.

Show them that we appreciate the energy and care they give to the children in our community. Here are some ideas to inspire you.

Show your child care provider you value them by:

- •Volunteering for a day at the center to see how the day is
 - Bringing flowers.
- Sending a card of thanks, feedback on a project, positive

observation. (This is a great idea for someone who is too pressured at pick-up and drop-off

•Bringing in items that are requested for craft projects.

•Surprising an overworked child care professional with pizza for supper. If you know someone who has a family day care business, this would be a real treat!

•Giving a gift certificate to a favorite beauty salon or coffee

•Celebrating the provider's birthday with something spe-

•Purchasing a small toy or program materials.

•Saying, "You're doing a great job" when you pick up a

•Telling the child care worker, "It's nice to know that I can leave my child here with you, knowing they are in a safe, happy, learning place. He/she loves to be

Surprisingly, when surveyed, the things providers requested most as a sign of value and respect from parents were a simple spoken "thank you" and the courtesy of paying and picking up children on time.

Children are a precious treasure. Take time this week to value them and to value the people who hold their hands and help them grow.




