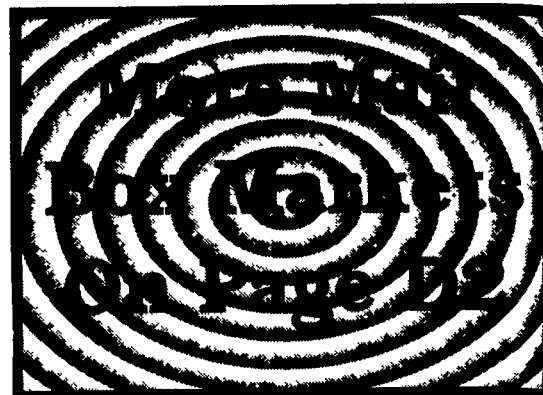

Participants had a chance to use the latest state-of-the-art sewing equipment supplied by the Husqvarna Viking Sewing Machine Company in cooperation with Fred Strobel's Sewing Center of Myerstown and Penn State Cooperative Extension. Guilford Mills of North Carolina and Pine Grove donated the fleece. Rich-

land Cutting cut the pullovers in advance using patterns designed by PDU of Reinholds.

The coats will be distributed through Lebanon County Christian Ministries, which works with other local agencies to provide for the needs of victims of domestic violence, fire, and economical hardship.

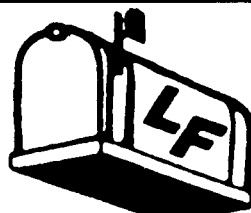
