

LANCASTER (Lancaster Co.) - "Discovering New England's Religious Heritage" provides a focus for the Lancaster Mennonite Historical Society's July 30-August 1 field trip. Open to the public, reservation will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis (\$365 per society member and \$385 per non-member) for one bus only by Mary Elizabeth Good, 2180 Millstream Road, Lancaster, PA 17602-1499.

Escorted by Samuel E. Wenger of Akron, Pennsylvania, the New England tour features a three-day trip to Massachusetts with a one-hour stop at New Pfalz (New York), visits to the Boston and Plymouth historical areas, two nights' lodging, tour

of downtown Boston, and a visit to Good Shepherd Christian Fellowship (Mennonite).

The group will see the Pilgrims' Plymouth, site of the earliest permanent settlement in New England (1620) and the branch of English Puritanism called Separatists.

Tour registration includes two nights' lodging (double occupancy), a deluxe continental breakfast on Friday and Saturday morning, all admissions, three evening meals, and printed materials. The motor coach will load at 6:45 a.m. at the Historical Society on July 30, leave at 7:00 a.m.; and return Saturday evening, August 1. Participants will pay their own noon lunches.

## HAM LOAF

Mix and form two loaves in 9x13-inch cake pan:  
Grind together:  
2 pounds ground ham  
2 pounds ground pork  
2 cups graham cracker crumbs  
½ cup milk  
3 eggs

Mix and pour over top:  
1 can tomato soup  
1 cup brown sugar  
½ cup vinegar  
½ cup water

½ teaspoon dry mustard  
Bake at 325 degrees for 2 hours.

## PEANUT BUTTER FINGERS

Cream together:

½ cup shortening  
½ cup granulated sugar  
½ cup brown sugar  
½ cup peanut butter

Add and mix together:

1 egg  
½ teaspoon vanilla

Add:

1 cup flour  
1 cup quick oats  
½ teaspoon baking soda  
½ teaspoon salt

Put in greased 9x13-inch pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes. Remove from oven. Sprinkle with 1 cup chocolate chips. Let stand 5 minutes then spread. Cool. Frost with:

1 cup confectioners' sugar  
½ cup peanut butter  
2 tablespoons milk

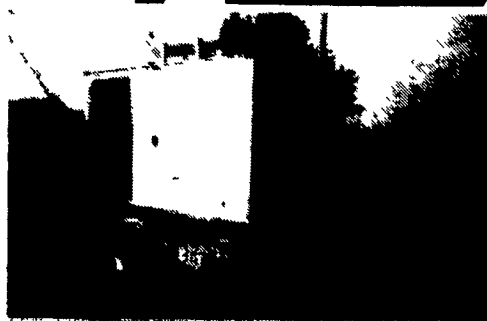
