To enter the drawing, select your favorite recipe, which must include a substantial amount of at least one dairy product. Dairy ingredients include milk, cream, sour cream, whipped cream, butter, yogurt, buttermilk, dry milk, ice cream, and any hard and soft cheeses. Please check your recipe carefully. Margarine and non-dairy substitutes such as whipped topping do not qualify as dairy products.

Dairy recipes are needed for appetizers, soups, breads, entrees, vegetables, desserts, beverages, snacks, and salads.

Clearly print or type your recipe. Be sure to give accurate measurements, temperatures, times, and sizes of baking dishes to use. We reserve the right to disqualify entries if these guidelines are not followed.

The difference between this contest and the weekly recipes is that you are asked to include a few paragraphs about yourself and your family. Although it is not required, a photograph of your family adds a wonderful touch to accompany the printed submission. Photos will be returned if you write your name and address on the back of the photo.

Only one entry per family allowed. This contest is for adults, not children. Kutztown Festival

KUTZTOWN (Berks Co.) - Authentic Pennsylvania Dutch farming and gardening techniques will be demonstrated at the annual Kutztown Pennsylvania-German Festival on the Kutztown Fairgrounds in Kutztown, from June 27 through July 5. New for 1998 to complement the antique farm equipment displays are antique cars, trucks and wagons loaned to the Festival by the Boyertown (Pennsylvania) Museum of Historic Vehicles.

The Old Time Plow Boys provide daily demonstrations of plow, cultivating, shingle

milling, corn grinding, and grain threshing. The Plow Boys preserve the antique farming equipment and methods which are an integral part of Pennsylvania's fascinating farming heritage. The group hosts the Festival's antique tractor pull contests on June 28 and July 5. They also sponsor a children's pedal-tractor contest and old-fashioned children's games like the hay bale toss, potato picking and corn shelling, so the young ones can have the hands-on experience of what it was really like to be a kid in the "olden days" in Colonial times when 80 percent

of the population tilled the soil to produce its sustenance.

Today, less than 2 percent of Pennsylvanians produce the agricultural yield to sustain a population of more than 225,000,000. This dramatic change came about through automation and continually improved farm machinery.
