ponents of the secretion bees use to determine forage patterns. The companies imitated the marker using the nasonov pheromone. The chemical is then placed on target crops like apple trees - and will attract honey bees to the area.

Tew said honey bees can probably memorize two to three blossom types at one time. "There's such a large variety of blooms in the world, and it's important apple trees don't get overlooked as bees head out of the hive in search of food.'

By using the chemical cue markers in an orchard, scientists can make sure apple trees are on the bees' list of "great restaurants.


