

Disaster Assistance Bill Provides \$253 Million In Emergency Funding

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Disaster assistance legislation initiated by National Farmers Union (NFU) was approved by Congress recently. Once signed into law, it will provide assistance in the amount of \$253 million to regions hit by flooding and blizzards this winter.

"Excessive rain in January and February resulted in some California dairy producers having to move their operations to higher ground, while producers in the Northeast suffered severe financial losses due to a series of crippling blizzards," said NFU President Leland Swenson.

The legislation passed by Congress provides \$160 million in agriculture disaster assistance, including \$34 million for the emergency conservation program, \$87 million for emergency farm operating loans, and \$80 million for emergency watershed and flood prevention. An additional \$93 million has been earmarked for farmer ownership and operating loans. Included in the agriculture disaster assistance funding is \$6.8 million designated to compensate producers for losses of milk that was produced but not marketed or for diminished milk production.

This February, NFU and the California Farmers Union requested that Congress consider additional funding for both the Emergency Loan and Emergency Conservation

Programs as well as expansion of the Dairy Indemnity Program to protect against production losses because of weather disasters. NFU also urged reauthorization of the Livestock Indemnity and Tree Assistance programs.

"NFU appreciates the action taken by Congress, the Clinton administration and the U.S. Department of Agriculture to assist these financially-devastated producers," said Swenson. "Most all of the requests made by NFU were addressed in legislation."

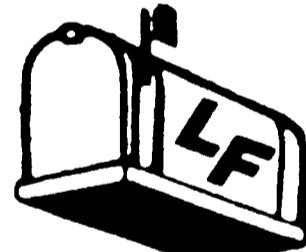
