Prices were unchanged for whites, and lower for whole egg and yolks. The market tone was steady for whites, and weak on the balance of items. Demand covered the full range, and was mostly fair. Supplies were at least adequate. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending May 2, 1998 were 3% greater than last week, and 9% more than the same week last year. Shell egg offerings to breakers were adequate to ample. Plants ran full to overtime schedules.

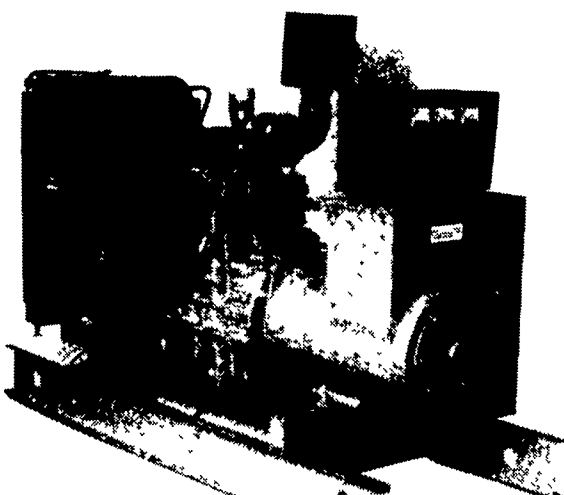

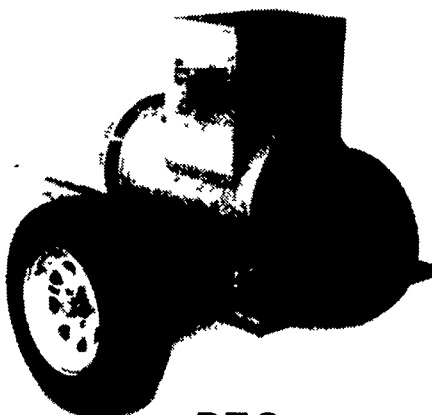

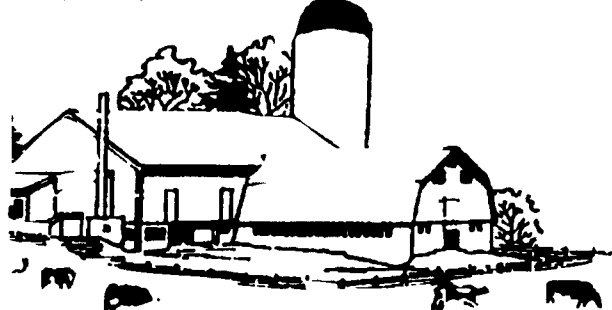
