Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers 1.00-2.00 lower. Stocker cattle and calves 2.00-4.00 lower. Demand moderate as buyers attempt to adjust feeders and stockers more in line with slaughter?le realizations. Quality of feeder cattle plain to attractive; stock? average at best. Feeder cattle in medium to fl? conditions. Stockers a? calves in medium flesh. Weigh-ups average. Slaughter cows and bulls 1.00-2.00 lower. Packer demand moderate. Least action from southern plants as drought in south Texas and old Mexico has many cows moving to market. Total? 500 cows and bulls sold?with 35 percent going to packers. Receipts this week 17,285; last week 11,131; last ye?74. Supply consisted of 86 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 11 percent calves and stockers under 600 lbs; 3 percent cows and bulls with only a third of these to packers. Prices follow with weighted averag?eight and price in parenthesis.

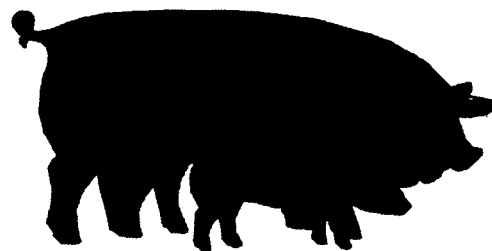

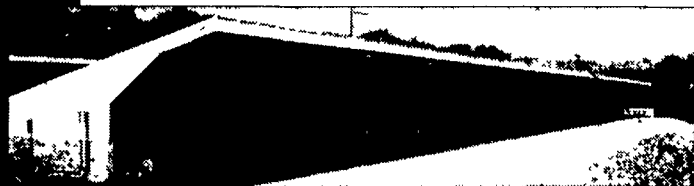

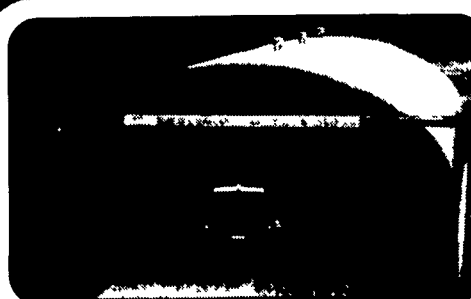
