



Schnecksville Community Fair Celebrating 15th Year

The 15th Annual Schnecksville Community Fair will be held at the fire company grounds on Route 309, Schnecksville, on June 22-27.

Fair hours are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 5 p.m. to 11 p.m., Friday from 5 p.m. to midnight, and Saturday from 3 p.m. to 11 p.m.

To celebrate their 15th Anniversary of the fair, the theme is "Kick Up Your Heels At The Fair," focusing on the fair goers having a good time at the country fair.

Only \$5 admission fee per person (more than 30 inches tall) admits you to Schnecksville Com-

munity Fair. This includes free parking, free exhibits, free entertainment, and best of all, unlimited amusement rides all day at no further cost! There will be 18 rides, which includes kiddie rides, with the midway host being Good-time Amusements.

Please note that this price does not include food, beverages, games, pony rides, the Lazer Tag Game, or Rock Climbing Wall. The objective of Pay One Price is to save money for families with children.

Opening Ceremony to kick off this six-day event is slated for Monday at 7:30 p.m. Samuel Hayes, Pennsylvania secretary of agriculture and Jane Baker, Lehigh County executive, are scheduled

to speak. Friends of the Fair awards will be presented. Cub Pack #57 will be participating in the flag ceremony.

One of the highlights of the 15th Annual Schnecksville Community Fair will be The Masters Of The Chainsaw X-treme Power Carving Competition scheduled for 7 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. Six of the country's top chainsaw artists will battle for more than \$4,000 in prize money. Between carving periods, the carvers will be available to answer questions on their unusual skill and occupation and all carvings produced will be available for sale. Make plans now to witness this most original event.

A new attraction to the Schnecksville Community Fair will be the Backhoe Rodeo sponsored by Powerco, Inc. The event is scheduled for Tuesday, June 23 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.; Thursday, June 25, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.; and Saturday, June 27, from 4 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Enjoy two evenings of spectacular fireworks displays. On Monday, Opening Day, enjoy a spectacular fireworks display by Pryro Tech at 9:30 p.m. (with the rain date Tuesday). Then again on

Friday at 11 p.m. enjoy a Fireworks Extravaganza (with the rain date Saturday).

Schnecksville Community Fair's pay one price will also include two new daily continuous shows. Appearing for the first time at the Schnecksville Fair: Razzmatazz, a magic and illusion spectacular, Vegas style, and JJ Huggles, that combines traditional clown skills and practiced showmanship, plus in-between shows he will stroll the fair in his little model-T Ford that puts on a show of its own. Back again will be Master of the Chainsaw, a skilled woodsman that carves unusual pieces of artwork with the chainsaw before your very eyes, out of a mere tree trunk. These unique handcrafted pieces will be available for purchase. Also returning back to Schnecksville Community Fair will be Lollipop The Clown, sponsored by Martin's Potato Chips.

Pay one price also includes seeing the competitive exhibits of handiwork, produce, and animals (sheep, pigs, steers, goats, rabbits, and chickens). Monday at 9 a.m. will be the judging of competitive exhibits (before the fair opens). Yocco's Quilt Competition will be judged then, with best of show receiving \$150!

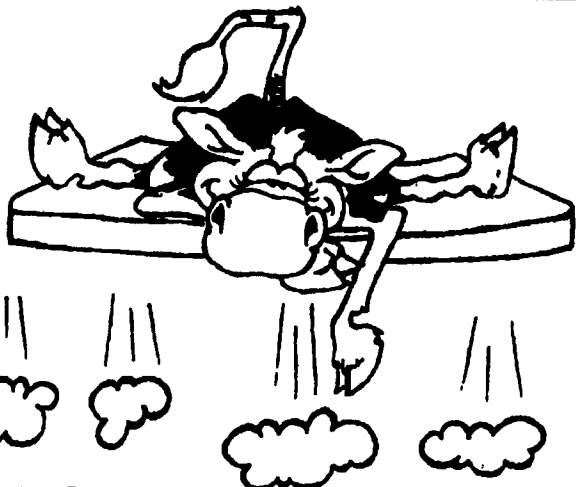
Kick up your heels and have the children participate in special children's events with hands-on educational experiences. Returning to Schnecksville Community Fair is Animal Specialities, a daily continuous hands-on educational experience, and Wanna Be A Farmer, which includes a hay maize to walk through, sandbox full of corn seeds for the children to play in,

various displays about learning farming, coloring books on agriculture, planting a seed in a container that the children may take home with them, plus so much more. The objective is to give children a better understanding of the principles of farming and applying it to everyday life.

A Kid's Pedal Tractor Pull Contest sponsored by National Penn Bank will be held at 4 p.m. Saturday. The contest is open to 5 to 10 years old and 11 and 12 years old weighing 100 pounds or less. Contestants can sign up previous to the event any time during fair week at the Information Booth. Cash prizes will be awarded in each of the six classes, with 1st prize - \$25, 2nd prize - \$15, and 3rd prize - \$10.
