Blue mold has been on a steady increase in the U. S. since 1990.

This increase is due to several reasons. First, long periods of favorable weather. Second, a change in the fungus which made it resistant to the major controlling fungicide used. Third, commercial production and transportation of transplants. Fourth, poorly equipped sprayers making the application of non systematic fungicides less effective.

The National Blue Mold

Forecasting Center at the North Carolina State University on May 20, listed blue mold active in Florida, Georgia, Cuba, Texas, Kentucky, and Tennessee. Two days earlier, they reported that "laboratory tests conducted thus far indicate the fungus involved is highly resistant to metalaxyl (Ridomil), but highly sensitive to dimethomorph (a component in Acrobat MZ)."

Blue mold (BM) generally moves into Pennsylvania from Kentucky and Tennessee. Pennsylvania growers should begin managing their tobacco crop to prevent blue mold. At this time of the year, tobacco

beds and greenhouses are the most vulnerable because they offer the best environmental conditions for BM to survive and multiply.

Plants should be kept dry as much of the time as possible. Apply fungicides on a regular basis, especially when new growth appears or after watering has washed fungicide off the plants. Rotate fungicides if possible to help prevent resistance development.

To protect the industry, a

community effort by all tobacco growers is essential. Once BM gets a foothold in one tobacco bed, greenhouse or field, it produces spores and spreads to neighboring fields.

Our ability to control this devastating disease, according to Dr. William Nesmith, North Carolina State University, "will be dependent upon the tobacco

industry operating in a community and regional effort for the benefit of all, rather than growers operating independently."
